- Sean Boyle – The CSC Board will be voting on funding at their next meeting next week. They started a new program in collaboration with the Roundtable and Kids at Hope for a six (6) week program starting June 24th entitled “More Than A Game”. There will be weekly basketball games and fatherhood classes for men.
- Garry Wilson – The Children’s Advocacy Center received a grant for \$1million to begin building.
- Debby Hawley – As Steering Committee Chair, she has been attending all of the Network meetings. Each of them are creating positive outcomes for the future.
- Tony Loupe – VPK will be offering a 200-hour summer program. They will be receiving over \$1million in Federal funding for providers starting in June.
- Carol DeLoach – We are the only Circuit in the state without an Advocacy Center for children. There will be big changes in prevention in the future, to help families before they go into the system.
