**1995**

Introduction to Office of Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) Comprehensive Strategy for Serious, Violent & Chronic Offenders.

**2000**

One of six pilots in the State of Florida to launch a St. Lucie Hand in Hand System of Care Comprehensive (Communities that Care - CTC).

10-year Risk & Protective Factor Strategic Plan adopted to improve the quality of life for children using the Communities that Care and Social Development Model funded by OJJDP. Only two of the six continue today.

Youth Leadership Council Developed.

Designated a "Promising Practice" by FMHI Study.

**2007**

FSU Grant awarded to develop Substance Abuse Coalition to address "Underage Drinking".

**2010**

Facilitated development of the first Teen Health Clinic developed with multi sector partnership later called the Teen Zone.

Named the first Kids at Hope community in the nation.

**1996**

Developed Truancy Assessment Center with multiple sector partners.

**2002**

Juvenile Drug Court development and funding.

**2006**

"Silence is Death" Campaign.

**2008**

HIV/AIDS prevention video produced with local doctors to be used with the school curriculum.

**2011 - 2013**

All Roundtable Networks reviewed county-wide data and created new objectives for the Hand in Hand Strategic Plan launched in 2000.

## 2014

St. Lucie County delegation traveled to Houston, TX to learn about the Comprehensive Gang Model (CGM); brought National Gang Center (NGC) to SLC to train 70 leaders and 200 residents on the CGM.

Launched the Comprehensive Gang Model.

## 2015

Facilitated multisector partnerships to respond to community concerns, including: SLC's free youth summer transportation program; CareerSource's youth summer employment program; DJJ's "Bridging the G.A.A.P." workshops for law enforcement, youth, and community members; USAO's Resource Reentry Hubs for previously incarcerated individuals.

Partnered with St. Lucie Public Schools to facilitate rollout of Acceleration Academy and Summer Slide technology.

Published St. Lucie Hand in Hand Community Assessment Report.

Secured funding and national training for Youth Leadership St. Lucie.

**2017**

Drug Free St. Lucie established and funded as a Drug Free Communities Grantee by the White House Office of National Drug Control policy to address underage drinking, marijuana use, and other drugs.

**2017**

Continued the implementation of the Comprehensive Gang Model and support for Safe Neighborhoods and the Lincoln Park Advisory Committee.

**2018**

Conducted a Gang Assessment by an independent evaluator that documented the contribution of the collective work of the Roundtable and the Safe Neighborhoods Network to the reduction of Gang Violence in St. Lucie County. Removed from the top 100 most dangerous cities.

**2019**

Established "St. Lucie RISE" Behavioral Health Network in response to Governor's Executive order to address school and community violence.

**2021**

Conducted Substance Misuse Community Assessment and developed strategic plan.

**2023**

St. Lucie RISE funded and established as a SAMHSA Partner for Success Grantee.

**2023**

Drug Free St. Lucie funded for an additional 5 years to implement substance misuse prevention strategies.

St. Lucie RISE established as the Roundtable's Mental Health Collaborative and partnered with Drug Free St. Lucie to reintroduce and serve as the Behavioral Health Network.

Transitioned Youth Leadership to the Helping Youth Pursue Excellence (H.Y.P.E) Coalition and established as a Sector Member for Drug Free St. Lucie.
